- 2.Burn images on disk in jpeg format, high resolution (300dpi)
- 3.Images should have black background and be labeled with number, media, size
- 4.A corresponding sheet should have artist name, numbers, title, size and media
- 5.Artist may also send prints (not required) – 8x10” for each submission with their CD

**All work must arrive ready to hang (wired) or for installation.**

Maximum size 48” wide – 72” high

Installation art must have artist on hand during installation
